

### Driving directions

#### Directions from Midlands and South (via M6)

1. Travel north until junction 20A of the M6
2. Take the M56 westbound, exiting at junction 12
3. Follow signs for the A533/Mersey Gateway
4. After crossing the Mersey Gateway, continue on the A562/A561 for 6 miles
5. At the roundabout, take the first exit onto the site of Estuary Commerce Park
6. On entering Estuary Commerce Park, cross the first roundabout, and at the second roundabout take the third exit onto De Havilland Drive
7. After 100 yards, turn right and then left into the Gencoa car park which is situated in front of the building

#### Directions from the North and East (via M62)

1. Head towards the M62 and continue westbound until junction 6
2. Take the A5300 following signs for Liverpool (S)
3. Continue until the junction, then take the 3rd exit onto the A562/A561
4. After the slip road, keep right and stay on the A561
5. Continue for 3 miles and at the roundabout, take the first exit onto the site of Estuary Commerce Park
6. On entering Estuary Commerce Park, cross the first roundabout, and at the second roundabout take the third exit onto De Havilland Drive
7. After 100 yards, turn right and then left into the Gencoa car park which is situated in front of the building

#### Directions from North Wales

1. Travel East towards the M56 and take the M56 eastbound, exiting at junction 12
2. Follow signs for the A533/Mersey Gateway
3. After crossing the Mersey Gateway, continue on the A562/A561 for 6 miles
4. After passing Toby Carvery and Dobbie's garden centre on the left, continue to the next roundabout and take the first exit onto Estuary Commerce Park.
5. On entering Estuary Commerce Park, cross the first roundabout, and at the second roundabout take the third exit onto De Havilland Drive
6. After 100 yards, turn right and then left into the Gencoa car park which is situated in front of the building

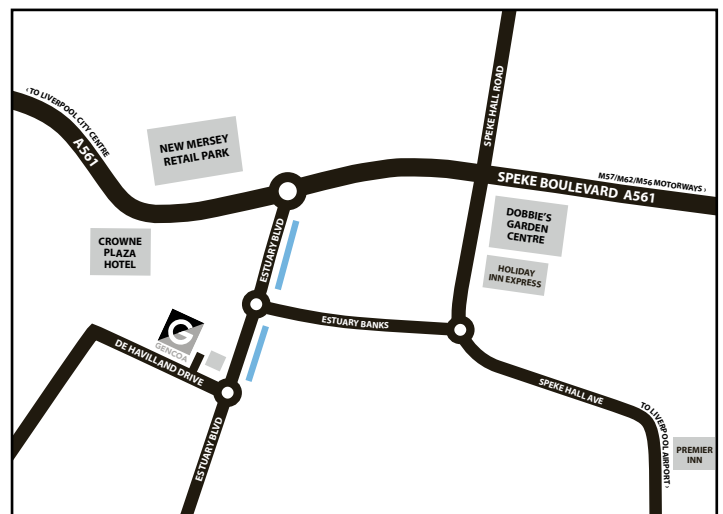
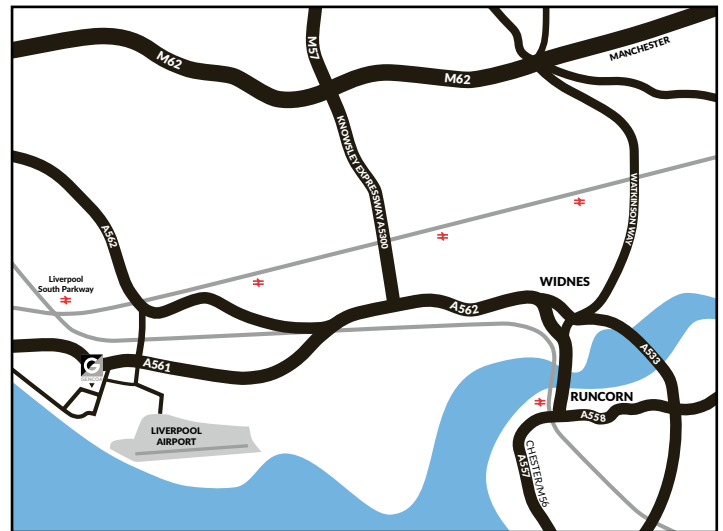
#### Directions from Liverpool City Centre

1. From the city centre, follow signs for A561 (Liverpool Airport)
2. Once on the A561, continue for 5 miles
3. After passing New Mersey Retail Park to the left, take the 3rd exit at the roundabout onto the Estuary Commerce Park site
4. On entering Estuary Commerce Park, cross the first roundabout, and at the second roundabout take the third exit onto De Havilland Drive
5. After 100 yards, turn right and then left into the Gencoa car park which is situated in front of the building

### By rail

Liverpool South Parkway serves trains from the Midlands, express services from Manchester Piccadilly, and local services on the City Line and Northern Line.

Runcorn is part of the route connecting Liverpool Lime Street and London Euston.



### Other information

#### Airports

Liverpool John Lennon Airport is situated 5 minutes from Gencoa. Manchester Airport is a 35-40 minute drive (via M56). For rail transport from Manchester Airport, change at Manchester Piccadilly for a service to Hunts Cross/Liverpool South Parkway.

#### Hotels

A number of hotels are available nearby, and are labelled on the regional map displayed above. A wide range of hotels are also available in Liverpool City Centre, located half an hour from Gencoa.

#### Parking

Onsite visitor parking is available.

#### Mersey Gateway toll charges

Bridge crossings are subject to a toll, payable at <https://www.merseyflow.co.uk/> Tolls can be paid in advance, or up to 11.59pm on the day after a crossing.
